I HAVE A HARD TIME IN FRONT OF THE CAMERA...NOW WHAT?

Planning your wedding day is so much fun! But sometimes when the wedding day arrives, it can turn out to be a bit more stressful than you imagined.

As your photographer, my intention is to make this day as easy and stress free for you as it can possibly be so you can enjoy your day, live in the moment, and party it up!

After a decade in the wedding industry I have established my own systematic approach to photographing weddings to make sure that every little thing you thought of and put into your wedding has been documented. The best pictures are the ones that are the most natural - the ones that are captured in-between poses. These are the memories we will create for you to cherish for years to come! I believe that engagement sessions are the perfect way for my couples to learn about how to feel comfortable in front of the camera and what I'm looking for to create care free and candid posing. Giving my couples direction and a solid base to their poses helps provide structure to the image, however, my goal from there is for you to take the lead and show your romance and personality!

No worries...If you need a little nudge, I can help with that too! You should expect to be laughing your butt off during your portrait session, giving lots of kisses, snuggling, giggling, telling secrets, and lots more belly laughs. This is supposed to be fun and my goal is to make sure you're loving every minute of it!

I have experience photographing in all lighting conditions and am comfortable and proficient using both natural and artificial lighting. WHAT DID YOU LIKE MOST ABOUT WORKING WITH MORGAN RUTH PHOTOGRAPHY?

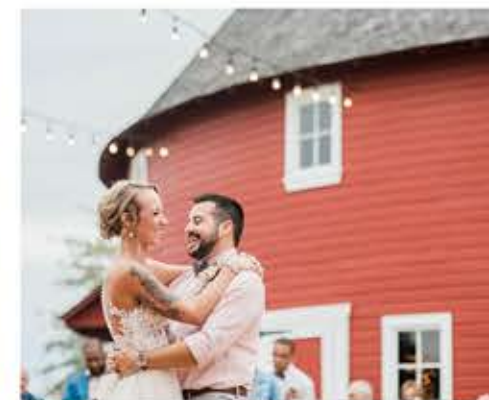

### WHAT DO YOU WISH YOU HAD DONE THAT YOU DID NOT?

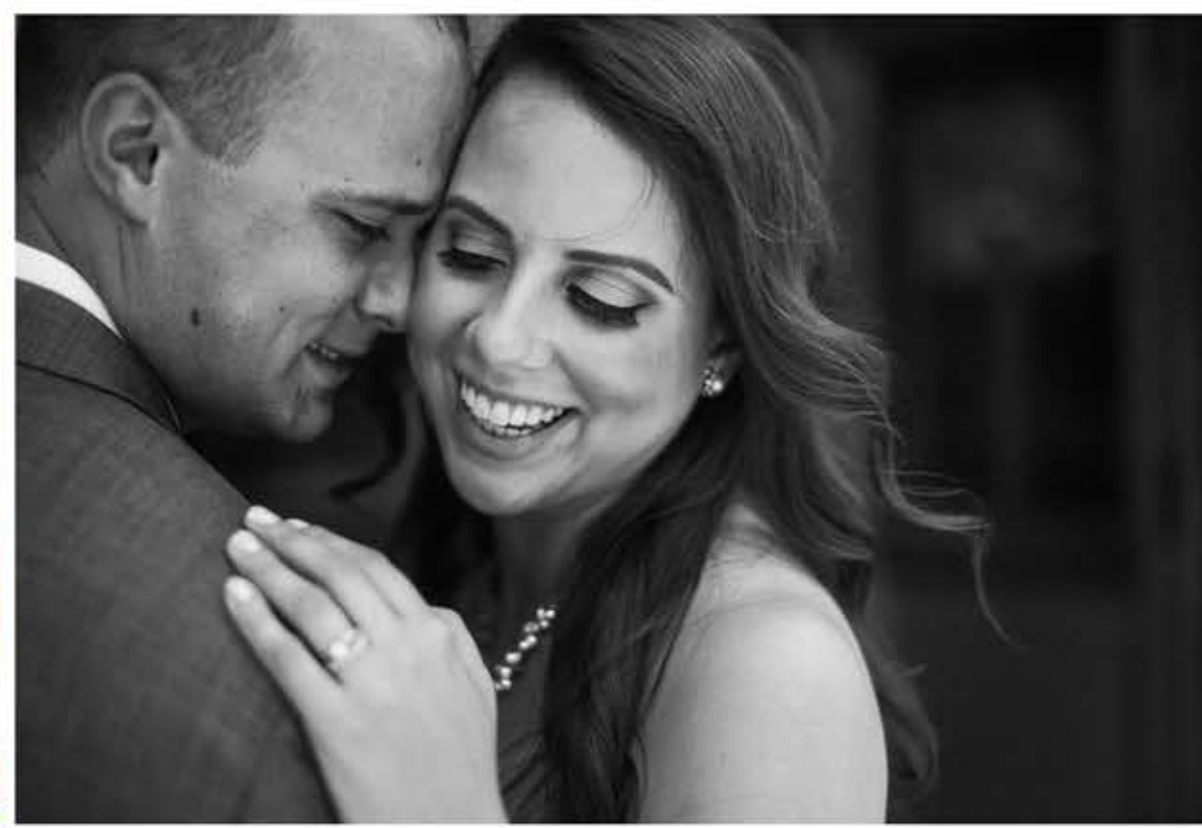
I wish we would've wrote our own vows or at least a letter to each other. It would've been nice to read back on that years from now.

## JUST A FEW TIPS...



-Be sure to have a hair and makeup trial at least a month before your wedding. This will give you peace of mind to know exactly how you will look and give you the opportunity to change things in advance if necessary. Make sure to bring all jewelry to the trial to see how makeup shades work with the pieces.

-Allowing 50% more time for hair and makeup than you originally anticipated alleviates the number one reason wedding schedules end up running late. This will assure you have plenty of time for all the portraits you want to take before the wedding.

-Find out what the rules for photographs are at the ceremony location. All venues are different, some restricting the location of photographs and even the times in which they are permitted.

-Have food delivered to your getting ready location. It may be hectic, but take the time to have a bite before the wedding since it will be a while before you have the opportunity to nourish yourself during the reception.

-Prepare an emergency bridal kit with clear nail polish, mints, a sewing kit, stain treater, Visine, safety pins, bobby pins, pain reliever, scissors, lip gloss, fashion tape and mini deodorant.



# Why First Looks are Awesome...

If possible, consider planning an intimate 'first look' and arrange to have your portraits taken before the ceremony.

Getting this step out of the way early in the day frees up the rest of your time to spend with your guests. After your ceremony you will be able to go straight to your cocktail hour and catch up with loved ones without the stress of rushing to complete your portraits between your ceremony and reception.

Guests will be thrilled that they don't have to wait long after the vows, as most of the family photos will already be out of the way. This is becoming a very popular wedding tradition that couples love, especially since they get more portrait time which means more portraits of them on their big day!





# SAMPLE WEDDING DAY TIMELINE

A wedding is a whirlwind of events, gone in the blink of an eye. There's little more important to a perfectly executed event than an organized timeline. Below is a typical schedule based off my most popular package option. This schedule would change a little if you decided to do a first look! Always remember that no event runs perfectly on time the whole time, which is why we make sure to add in buffer time in all possible places! Remember to have a fantastic team of vendors running your wedding day so you can relax and have a good time!



🕒 12:00pm - Getting ready  
Photographers arrive to the getting ready site.. Photograph everyone's final touches of getting ready for the day. Photograph bridal details, groom details, and bride putting on dress.

🕒 2:15pm - Pre ceremony, Deep breath!  
Guests begin to arrive, wedding party should be hidden away. Photographers photograph ceremony space and details, guests arriving, and prepare equipment for the ceremony & family portraits. Take this time to have a refreshment, touch up your makeup, and regroup before all of the excitement begins!



🕒 3:00pm - Ceremony, Here we go!!  
🕒 3:40pm - Family portraits, Just keep smiling!  
🕒 4:00pm - Wedding party portraits  
Photograph the wedding party together, bride with the bridesmaids, groom with the groomsmen, bride, groom, and bride & groom together.



🕒 6:00pm - Arrive at the reception venue  
Photographers head inside first to prepare equipment for the wedding party announcement & reception and inform the DJ of the wedding party's arrival. Let the party begin!

🕒 8:00pm - Sunset and/or night time portraits  
Photographers and the bride & groom head outside the reception venue to capture a few portraits in front of the sunset or in the dark using off camera lighting to capture and showcase the beauty of your venue at night. These shots usually take about 15-20 minutes of your time and have become something each of our couples look forward to and is a good time for your to step back from the chaos of your big day and soak each other up!

🕒 9:00pm - Photographers leave  
We pack up our equipment and prepare to leave for the day. But first we will check in with you to make there are no further photos you wish to have taken or if you would like to add any additional photography coverage of your wedding reception.

## THE DETAILS TELL THE STORY...

WHAT TO PREP FOR "GETTING READY" PHOTOS

So many things are special about your wedding day. While they may seem like small details, the unassuming pillow your ring bearer carried might have been made from your Christening gown. Or those shoes with the delicate pearl buttons may have been your mother's. These are the smaller details that tell the story of your special day, that we document for you! Whether it's your bouquet or your shoes or your something blue, it's all a part of your distinct personality as a couple, sharing your yesterdays while you prepare for your many tomorrows. Please have these details that I have listed set aside, possibly in a box or tote, so that when we arrive to your wedding we can quickly begin photographing them for you!

- 1 | ALL OF THE RINGS. This includes the bride's engagement ring & wedding band as well as the groom's wedding band.
- 2 | BRIDAL JEWELRY. Necklace, bracelet, rings, and earrings.
- 3 | BRIDAL ATTIRE. Dress, veil and/or hair piece, and shoes. Don't forget your hanger if you have a special one to use!
- 4 | INVITATION SUITE. Bring a set of your invitation in a stamped and addressed (to a family member) envelope.
- 5 | WEDDING DAY ESSENTIALS. Perfume, lipstick and gloss, clutch.
- 6 | FLORALS. Arrange for your bouquets to be delivered while getting ready to be used in photos.
- 7 | VOWS. If writing your own vows, a written copy is a great addition to your wedding day details!
- 8 | GIFTS & LETTERS. If you are planning to gift your wedding party, family, or do bride and groom gifts or letters, please let us know!
- 9 | TRADITIONAL ITEMS & HEIRLOOMS. Something old, something new, something borrowed, and something blue.
- 10 | GROOM. Tux/Suit, pocket square, shoes, boutonniere, socks, belt, watch, cuff links, tie clip, tie/bowtie, wedding ring, &







## LET'S SNEAK AWAY FOR A FEW...



Before I leave a wedding I make a point to snag my couple out of their reception for just a couple minutes.

I take this opportunity with them to capture some more "candid and romantic" shots now that the nerves have settled and everyone is relaxed and having a good time.

Sometimes I take them out to use some soft golden sunset light and sometimes its to do something fun in the dark. Rain or shine, these shots are always magical and a client favorite! Sometimes, if you're lucky, we get to do a little sunset fun and some night time shots!

These portraits do not take long, don't worry, your guests are busy dancing and probably won't even know you stepped away to steal some kisses.



## WHY INVEST?

Photography is just as important today as it was 100 years ago. If anything, with the surge in popularity of social media, photography is one of the most sought after commodities today. Your children, grand-children, and even great-grandchildren will want to know what their parents, grandparents, and great-grandparents looked like on their big day. This is important to me so that I can further provide high quality imagery and emotional portraiture to my couples. This has also provided me the confidence to photograph in fast paced situations, tricky lighting situations with both natural light and flash, and in new, ever changing, environments.

### REAL TALK...

#### THEY GIVE YOU A CHANCE TO CONNECT WITH YOUR WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHER...

The more time you spend with your photographer, the more comfortable you'll become in front the lens. When you relax, your quirks and true personality come out which makes your photographs more authentic. When your wedding day comes, you'll feel so much more at ease with your photographer because they are someone you know and are comfortable with. Remember, your photographer is a person who will be right with you for HOURS on your wedding day, capturing intimate moments and unique details, and documenting one of the most significant and emotional days of your life. In all honesty, if you don't have a good working relationship with your photographer, things have the potential to get pretty awkward. When you have an engagement session, it allows you to spend productive time with your photographer and build a lasting relationship, which is one of the most important parts of the experience to me.

#### THEY'RE A GOOD CHANCE TO FOCUS ON EACHOTHER AND ONLY EACHOTHER...

Shut out any lingering awkward memories of school photos and painfully posed prom photos; your engagement session is all about the unique love you share. Your engagement is such a special time in your life, it is a new chapter in your love story. You deserve to document this part of your story just as much as the next and to really spend a couple hours focusing entirely on your relationship and showing each other off to the world.

With that said, not everyone is comfortable in front of the camera (I know I feel totally awkward and unnatural when a camera is pointed at me) Your engagement sessions gives me a chance to show you that it really is a lot of fun and there is no reason to be nervous at all. For your engagement session you need to be prepared to: have fun, cuddle, kiss, tickle, laugh, and just be in love with each other, I will take care of the rest!

#### YOU GET TO SPEND TIME IN A PLACE YOU LOVE DOING THINGS YOU LOVE

One of the things I love doing and encourage couples to do is think of a meaningful location for their session. Your engagement session is totally unique to you, just like your wedding. No two are the same. I always urge my couples to add elements of "who they are" to their session to make it even more special. This is a chance for you to truly show who you are and what you love to do together. From the location to any props or little details added to the pictures, it is totally about you. This is an opportunity to show what your life together is really like. Are you dog lovers? Great, bring your dog! Brainstorm together to make it more personal and fun for you both. In addition, I think being in a familiar location you are comfortable in helps you to feel comfortable in front of the camera too!

#### A PERFECT OPPORTUNITY FOR A TEST RUN

As I've mentioned, not only is this a great opportunity to have a test run and learn how to pose and react while on camera, but why not make it even more of a grand event and schedule a trial with your wedding day hair and makeup team! Your engagement session is a perfect chance to test out your wedding makeup and have your hair curled! This allows you the chance to see how everything looks in person and on film. Don't forget to get your nails done...not that you needed an excuse, right? (Wink Wink)

## THE EXPERIENCE

### FROM INQUIRY...

The weeks prior to and directly following your wedding planning are busy times. I totally understand your excitement and honor that with a special timeline which will help you to understand how we are working our hardest to avoid any unnecessary surprises:

**At initial inquiry:** If I am available to photograph your wedding, I will respond to your email with this magazine that you're currently reading! Yay! If you like what you see we can set up an in person consult or phone consult to answer any questions you may have...or we can continue via email. Relationships are important to me and I encourage everyone to make a point for us to meet sometime prior to the wedding day. If you wish to book your wedding with me, I will forward over a link to your online booking website where you can select the perfect investment collection for you, sign a contract, and pay your retainer. Throughout your engagement we will stay in close contact so I can assist with any planning help you may need and even complete your engagement session if you chose that option!

**4 weeks before your wedding:** Over email or phone, or maybe even a coffee date, we will finalize your wedding day timeline complete with official arrival and departure times, venue addresses, emergency contacts, photo locations, family photo lists, and other vendor information.
